Supplementary Table 1: Fraction of interactions with shared GO annotation.

Shared annotation for interacting pairs in the FYI [1] and the full HC network were calculated. Statistical significance of differences in the fraction of shared annotation between FYI and HC were computed using Fisher's Exact Test ($P < 0.01$). Only those interactions are considered in which both protein partners have a known GO annotation.
