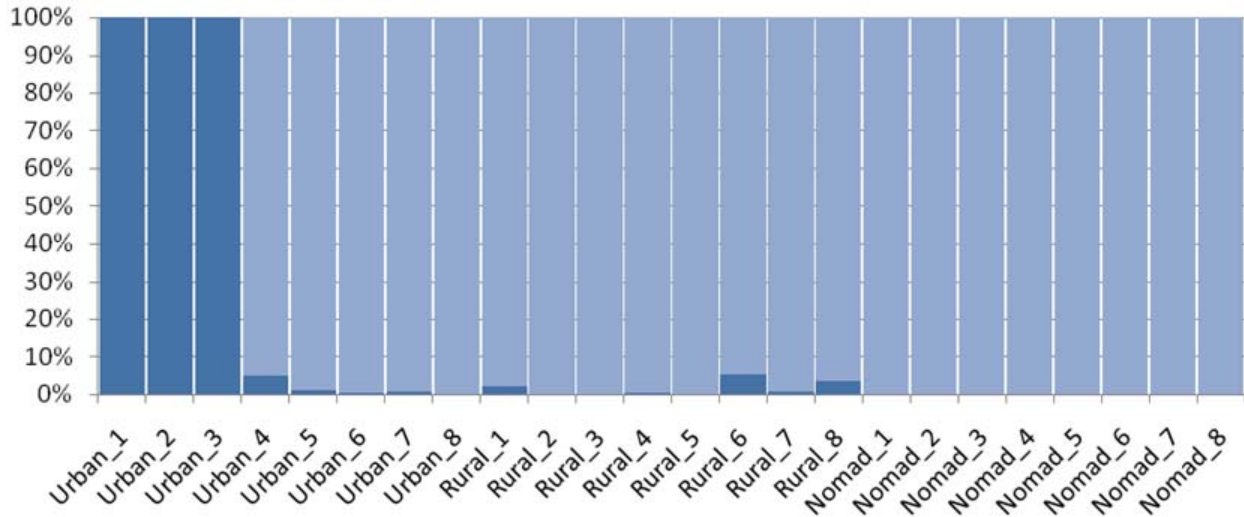


Figure S4. Structure analysis of genotypic variation. Each individual is represented by a column that is partitioned into K colored segments representing the proportion of ancestry (Q value) from each of the K clusters for each individual using 11,000 autosomal SNP markers. Two Structure run at $K = 2$ and $K = 3$ are shown. At $K = 3$, 80% of individuals have high membership coefficient to one cluster.
