
The Panel approved human subjects involvement in your research project on September 24, 2004. If there is a contract involved, it must be signed before subject recruitment and enrollment.

If this proposal is used in conjunction with any other human experimentation or if it is modified in any way, it must be re-approved for these special circumstances. **Note that all adverse events, occurring here and at other institutions, should be reported to both the Human Subjects and Biosafety Panels regardless of whether or not the events are thought to be related to the gene transfer intervention.**

All continuing projects and activities must be reviewed and re-approved at least annually by the Panel. Panel approval of any project is for a maximum period of one year. It is the responsibility of the investigator to submit quarterly reports to the Panel and to resubmit the project to the Panel for continuing review.

Please remember that all data including all signed consent form documents must be retained for a minimum of three years past the completion of this research. Additional requirements may be imposed by your funding agency, your department, or other entities.
