OVERVIEW

In accordance with the annotation to the Appendix II listing for the African Lion adopted at the 17th Conference of the Parties to CITES (CoP17) in October 2016, South Africa is required to establish an export quota for lion bones. The South African Scientific Authority is mandated to advise the Department of Environmental Affairs (DEA) on the size of the quota on an annual basis.

In order to provide sound scientific decision support to the DEA, a research project has been initiated by the South African Scientific Authority with the following aims to: (1) increase our understanding of the captive lion breeding industry and trade in lions (especially bones, but also other products and live lions) in South Africa; (2) investigate the trade in captive produced lion bones under a quota system; (3) gain a better understanding of the consequences of the US ban on imports of captive-origin trophies; and (4) strengthen the evidence base for the annual review of the lion bone export quota.

INVITATION

We hope you will take part in this study by completing this questionnaire. You do not have to answer all the questions, but we would appreciate you answering as many questions as honestly as possible. If there are certain activities that the facility does not do (e.g. hunting), then you will be automatically redirected to a different set of questions.
